DISPENSING COURSE FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

INTRODUCTION

The course is based on the recommended standard for the dispensing course for prescribers in terms of Medicines and Related Substance Control Act (Act 101) as amended.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The course is offered through a combination of self-study, 1 or 3 day workshop and facilitator guidance and support. A successful candidate receives certificate within 3 months of enrolment.

COURSE OUTCOMES

- Identify and apply ethical, legal and therapeutic considerations in all facets of dispensing.
- Evaluate prescription and access patient profile.
- Dispense the prescription.
- Manage the procurement, storage and distribution of medicines.
- Advice patients to ensure quality use of medicines and improve health status.

The course is applicable to registered and practicing health professionals namely: Professional Nurses and Medical Practitioners.

CERTIFICATION
